Made exclusively with Recycled HDPE: HDPE is one of the most commonly recycled plastics, second only to PET, and can be combined with HDPE bottles in recycling systems.

Widely Recyclable: 87% of the U.S. population has access to recycling #2 plastic, making it widely recyclable, according to a study by the Sustainable Packaging Coalition.

Global Acceptance and Demand: #2 plastic is globally accepted for recycling and is highly valued by plastic reclaimers due to its repurposing benefits and established end markets.
